

MrGOLF 2012 RULES

ENTRY FEE: \$100 PER TEAM

BUDGET: \$25,000,000

MINIMUM COST PER GOLFER: \$700,000 (because the No. 125 finisher in 2011 earned approx. \$668K)

DESCRIPTION AND RULES:

Using the above budget, each participant selects a team of **twelve (12) different golfers**. You may choose ANY golfer from ANYWHERE in the world, including graduates of the Nationwide Tour, the PGA Q School, Europe, Asia, etc., however, MrGOLF uses only **OFFICIAL PGA TOUR EARNINGS** in its calculations. Earnings of golfers who are **NOT** members of the PGA Tour will **NOT** be used in this pool.

- A golfer's cost is the amount equal to his official 2011 PGA Tour earnings, but not less than **\$700,000**. (A list of the 2011 top 200 is provided for your convenience and information.)
- The winning team will be the one with the highest **2012 TOTAL OFFICIAL PGA Member earnings**, calculated by tallying the **official 2012 PGA Member money** earned by each golfer on the team.
- Participants may enter more than one team (under different names, e.g. Wanker 1, Wanker 2, to avoid confusion).
- MrGOLF Canada administrators will provide lists of official year-to-date earnings throughout the season for golfers selected in the pool. Notices of updates will be sent by e-mail only or one can view earnings information from the PGA Tour's website at www.pgatour.com.
- Team rosters, standings, etc. will be posted at www.mrgolfcanada.com
- **Each team entered is entitled to make THREE (3) trades during the season (see the Trade Option sheet).**

TO ENTER THE POOL:

- **\$100 per team; by CHEQUE payable to [ROBERT LAING](#) or by Interac Funds Transfer;**

- **Use [MsExcel](#) to list your players and attach the Excel file to your e-mail message and send it to randy@mrgolfcanada.com. DO NOT USE the MsWORD Entry Form for e-mail**

The first PGA Tour event of 2012 starts on January 5th so entries and payments must be submitted by

December 30th, 2011

PAYOUTS: \$200 from the total entry fees collected will be used to cover administration costs of MrGOLF 2012. The remainder will be distributed to winners as described below.

Once the administrators of MrGOLF 2012 know how many teams are entered and how much total money will be available, the payout amounts will be determined then disclosed to all participants, along with a complete roster of all teams.

MONTHLY PRIZES:

The team that **GAINS** the most in EARNINGS each month in 2012 will win **\$100**, calculated at the end of the last tournament that **STARTED** in that calendar month. October and November are treated as one month because there are usually only a couple tournaments in November.

JACKPOT POOL WINNERS: **** ONLY the 2012 PGA Tour Official Member's Money List is used for MrGOLF 2012. Other "World" earnings and FedEx Cup earnings do not count.**

- The Jackpot Pool is the total amount in the pool less the money paid out in monthly prizes. The number of winners and the payout amounts will be determined by the total amount in the pool.
- Tiebreaker/Playoff – In the unlikely event that two or more teams finish with identical total winnings at any prize-winning level, the team whose golfers won the most tournaments will be the winner of that prize. If there is still a tie, the prize monies for that level and the number of levels below it, based on the number of teams which are tied will be totalled and split evenly between/amongst those teams, the same way that prize money is distributed on the PGA Tour. Example: Team A, Team B and Team C tie for second place. Team B WON more tournaments than the other two – Team B takes second prize. Teams A and C are still tied – they split 3rd and 4th place money. Tiebreaker rules do not apply to monthly awards – they will be split in the event of a tie.

PLEASE NOTE: If a golfer is NOT a member of the PGA Tour, his earnings are NOT considered OFFICIAL PGATour Earnings. CAVEAT EMPTOR.
