

MrGOLF 2012 – Trading Guidelines

Here's how to make a Trade:

- a) Participants will be entitled to make up to THREE (3) trades per team. This feature is included in your team's entry fee; there is no additional charge for trades.
- b) Making a trade is not mandatory, it is an option.
- c) Send an e-mail to “randy@mrgolfcanada.com” with your trade instruction. Use the following very simple, easy to apply format:

IN THE SUBJECT LINE state “MrGOLF Trade for 'TEAM NAME”
IN THE MESSAGE BODY state “DROP Golfer Name, ADD Golfer Name”
That's all that's required.

- DO NOT** send a spreadsheet with the name of the replacement/new golfer inserted.
DO NOT send to an address OTHER THAN “randy@mrgolfcanada.com” because if you do, there's a chance that your message will not be picked up and your trade will not be processed.
- d) The BUDGET RULE continues to apply. 2011 Official PGA Tour earnings (or the minimum of \$700,000) of each golfer still determine the costs of golfers being acquired through trades so make sure that, post-trade, your team is still within the \$25 million budget. In other words, if the golfer you want to add is more costly than the golfer you are dropping, recalculate the total cost of the team to ensure budget compliance. MrGOLF will reject trades that put teams over budget and you might not be able to correct the error until the following month.
 - e) The 12 golfers per team rule does not change.
 - f) Trades become effective with the first tournament that **starts** after the beginning of a month. Your instruction to “randy@mrgolfcanada.com” must be received at least one day before the start of the first tournament of the month.
 - g) Please note that because of the small number (if any) of tournaments in November that it is considered as part of October, therefore, the last trades of the season are for the start of October.
 - h) Your original golfer's earnings for the 2012 season **until** the trade takes place count in your team's total. The replacement golfer's 2012 earnings **from** when the trade takes place count in your team's total.
 - i) You may use a trade to reacquire a golfer that you had dropped earlier in the season

All participants will be made aware of all trades made as they show in the Teams spreadsheet.
